Good afternoon, Chair Manalo and Commissioners.

I'm Dr. Esroruleh Mohammad, clinical psychologist and author of the BureauCare-to-Custody-Cemetery Pipeline™ (BCCP™) and the B2C3A™ Pipeline Prevention Model—entered into the County record on April 10, 2025; U.S. Copyright TXu 2-486-534.

Your agenda tracks the core lanes of these frameworks: the Annual Report to the Board, the CARE Court stakeholder directive, and approval of the July 24 minutes. In brief: the puzzle has been named. BCCP™ diagnoses the repeating pattern—BureauCare to Custody to preventable mortality—and B2C3A™ sets a prevention model built on navigation, diversion, postvention, and data-sharing/consent that protects families' rights.

This is a recognition-only filing. I'm not disclosing methods or seeking delay. I respectfully request three concrete steps:

1. Correct the July 24 minutes before approval to reflect my written comment and to name both frameworks—BCCP™ and B2C3A™—as previously submitted to this body.
2. Where the Annual Report or CARE Court planning overlaps, include a neutral prior-work line to preserve provenance:
“Concepts overlap with the BureauCare-to-Custody-Cemetery Pipeline™ (BCCP™) and B2C3A™ Pipeline Prevention Model (Mohammad; entered into County record Apr 10, 2025; U.S. Copyright TXu 2-486-534).”
3. For the required CARE Court stakeholder forum, publish dates and access details and commit to posting early-warning/access metrics—navigation, diversion, postvention, and data-sharing/consent—disaggregated for equity analysis, so prevention isn't replaced by punitive responses.
